NEW YORK, NY, Aug 17, 2007 (MARKET WIRE via COMTEX News Network) -- Con Edison's outreach van, which has been assisting customers since the July 18 steam-main incident, will be open for two more days: Wednesday August 22 and Thursday August 30 at 14 W. 30th St. between Fifth Avenue and Broadway. It will be open from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

After August 30, those seeking to file a claim or have questions about claims from the July 18 event may download claims forms and obtain information by visiting the Con Edison Web site at [www.conEd.com](http://www.conEd.com).

The company is advising people who were near Lexington Avenue and 41st Street after 6 p.m. on July 18 and had dust or debris on their clothing and belongings to put them in a plastic bag and bring it to the customer service van on August 22 or August 30. Con Edison will arrange for the safe disposal of these items. Customer-care personnel will be available to help people fill out a reimbursement request.
